

Testing & quarantine measures for fully vaccinated international attendees

Register your vaccination history on the Q-CODE website

From 1 April 2022, you are exempt from quarantine if you can prove you are fully vaccinated.

You do this by registering your vaccination history in the Korean government's Q-CODE system:

We recommend using your mobile or tablet to access Q-CODE here

You can register early and save your progress. Please be ready to provide:

- ✓ Valid passport information
- ✓ Valid flight information
- ✓ Valid accommodation address
- ✓ COVID-19 vaccination certificate
- ✓ 2 days before departure to Korea, a negative result of a PCR test taken (see next step)



Complete your WGC2022 registration in full

We advise you to book your accommodation, as you will need your hotel address



Identify your chosen flights

You don't need to book yet, but please have your travel itinerary confirmed



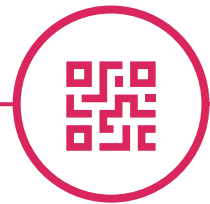
Arrange your Travel Visa

Some countries are eligible for the Korea Electronic Travel Authorization (K-ETA) visa waiver. Read more [here](#)



Reserve your arrival PCR test

To avoid queues, you can reserve your test online at [Safe2Go](#)



Receive your QR code from Q-CODE

You are required to show this to Korean immigration officials upon entry



Enter your test results in Q-CODE

The test information must be written in English or Korean



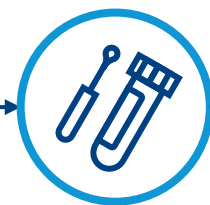
From midnight, 2 days before your departure date, complete your PCR test

E.g., if your flight is at 14:00 on Friday 20 May, you can test from 00:01 on Wednesday 18 May.

Note that self-administered PCR tests, or RAT / lateral flow tests are not valid.

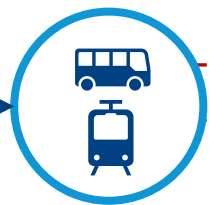


Arrive at Incheon International Airport, Seoul



Complete PCR test at airport

Please kindly note that tests are at attendees' expense (₩80,000, or approx. USD \$65)



Transit to your hotel by WGC2022 limousine bus, car or train

Your results will be provided via email 6 hours after completing your PCR test. We kindly ask you remain in your room until then

You will be required to self-isolate in a healthcare facility for 7 days. Please note this is at your own expense.

Plans for 23 May onward

The Korean government plans to ease quarantine from 'mandatory' to 'recommended', as long as the COVID situation does not worsen. Please check the website FAQs for further guidance.

Staying in Korea more than 7 days?

You are required to have an additional test on the 6th or 7th day of your stay in Korea. Guidance on requirements, and how to access testing near EXCO will be available shortly.

According to the Korean government plan, 7-day quarantine for those who have tested positive for COVID-19 will be eased from 'mandatory' to 'recommended' on May 23, as long as the COVID-19 situation does not worsen. Further details will be updated so please check the WGC2022 FAQs later.
